CALIFORNIA AVENUE & TEMESCAL STREET WATER MAIN RELOCATION PROJECT

Background


As part of the Fair Oaks Park & Recreation District's project to improve the Village Park area, the Fair Oaks Water District (FOWD) will be relocating a water main from within the park site to California Avenue and installing new connections on Temescal Street.

What to Expect

Construction activity will begin with heavy equipment and materials appearing at the site, highlighted in red on the map below, in June of 2022. At times the contractor may need to close off access on a section of California Ave. and Temescal St. for the safety of the public and their staff. Construction may cause unavoidable short-term inconvenience to

residents and business in the immediate vicinity. The FOWD will attempt to provide a minimum of 48-hour notice to anyone that will have an interruption in their water service. Work will generally occur within 7am-5pm weekdays. Construction is estimated to take approximately 4 weeks. We appreciate your understanding as we make these improvements.
