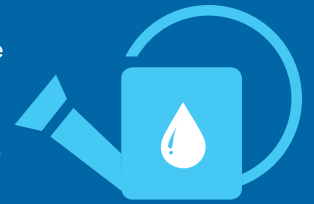


WHAT DOES A 20% REDUCTION *in water use look like?*



HOUSEHOLD WATER USE

The average Sacramento-area household uses 350 gallons of water per day, with most water used outdoors. Here are some easy tips to reduce water use. Find the right combination for you to reduce by 20 percent or 75 gallons per day.



CHECK THE SOIL
BEFORE WATERING

saves

80 GALLONS
per day



ADJUST SPRINKLER TO WATER
PLANTS, NOT DRIVEWAY

saves

40 GALLONS
each time you water



USE MULCH ON SOIL
SURFACE

saves

30 GALLONS
per 1,000 sq. ft. each time
you water



WATER PLANTS EARLY
IN THE AM

saves

50 GALLONS
each time you water



FIX HOUSEHOLD
LEAKS

saves

30-50 GALLONS
per day



INSTALL HIGH-EFFICIENCY
SPRINKLERS

saves

8 GALLONS
per 1,000 sq. ft. per day



INSTALL DRIP-IRRIGATION

saves

15 GALLONS
each time you water



INSTALL A "SMART"
CONTROLLER

saves

100 TO 150 GALLONS
per day
